


Defense Contract Obligations Robust Increase








Products are Driving the Growth in Recent Years







In 2018, Growth Spread Beyond Aviation




No Real Recovery with Weapon System Pipeline








OTA Usage Up Across DoD




Army Remains OTA Leader








Big Five Decline; Even Growth Across Rest








Vendor Count/New Entrants Continues to Decline
