


OPTIMIZING LOGISTICS SUPPORT FOR BALLISTIC MISSILE DEFENSE SHIPS IN SIXTH FLEET

Finding the optimal placement of critical ship parts that directly support Ballistic Missile Defense (BMD) ships deployed and stationed in Europe



This report informs and recommends to decisionmakers where and how many critical parts should be staged to best support the operational readiness of BMD ships on European Phased Adaptive Approach missions



Research analyzes eight highdemand, high-failure, high-dollar value spares that are critical to AEGIS

Utilizing a mathematical model based on several logistics factors, the report concludes that all forward-staged parts should be located at Naval Support Activity Souda Bay to effectively support BMD ships in Sixth Fleet.
