
WEAPONS SYSTEM ACQUISITION REFORM ACT (WSARA) IMPLEMENTATION AND COST ANALYSIS

Objectives Summary

Analyze the effects of Title II WSARA 2009 legislation on the Program Executive Office (PEO) Combat Support and Combat Service Support (CS&CSS). Review collected program cost data to determine a correlation between WSARA implementation and how stakeholders perceive the application of these regulations.



Findings

MDAP cost variability is in more control since the implementation of WSARA

Unnecessary and outdated policy reforms still in use complicate a program's ability to execute a streamlined acquisition process and fully implement current reform

Alignment of program incentives, including personnel evaluations, reporting procedures, and requirements with reform policy increased policy adherence
