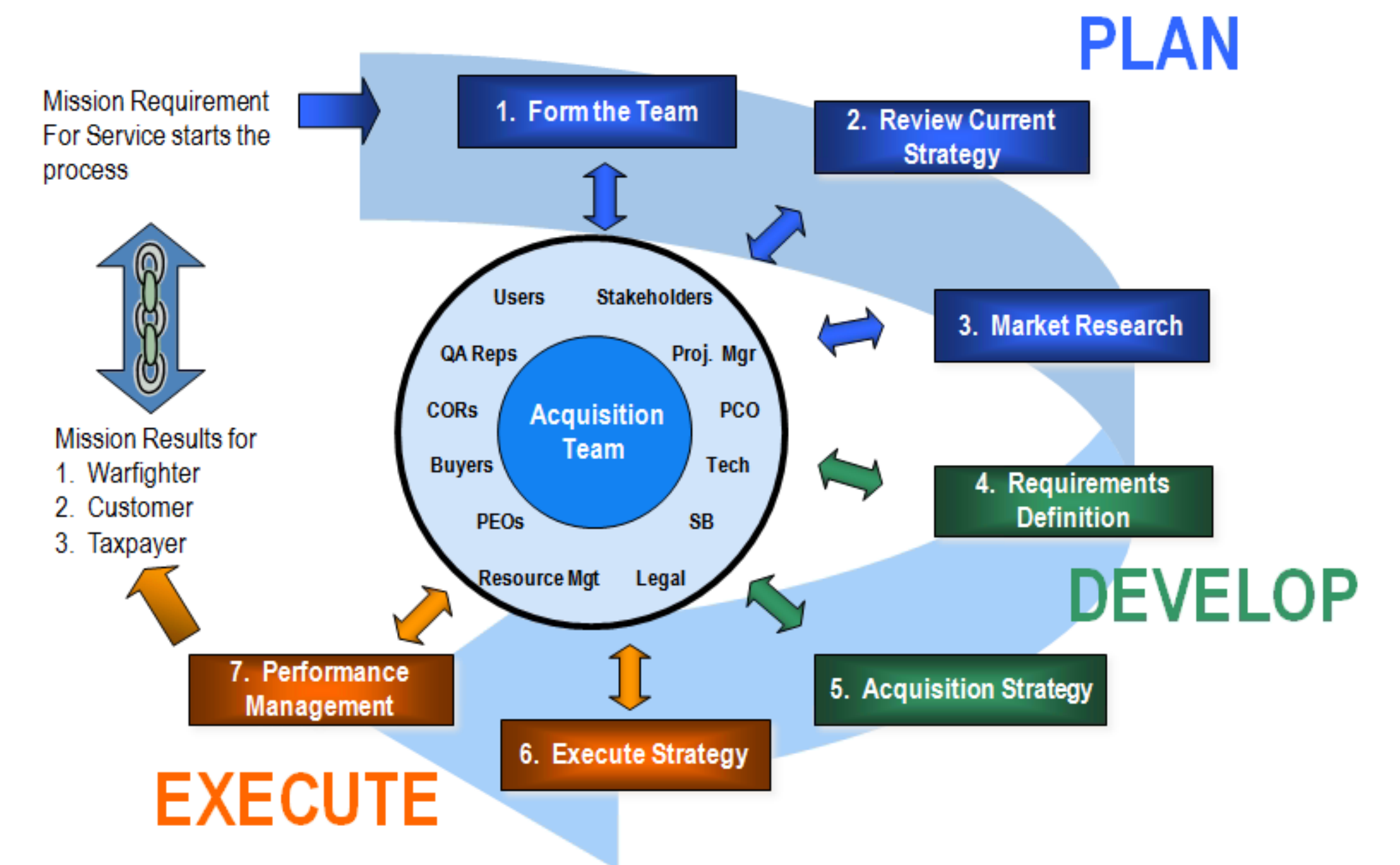


Relationship between Contracting Officer Representatives (CORs), Surveillance, and Contractor Performance

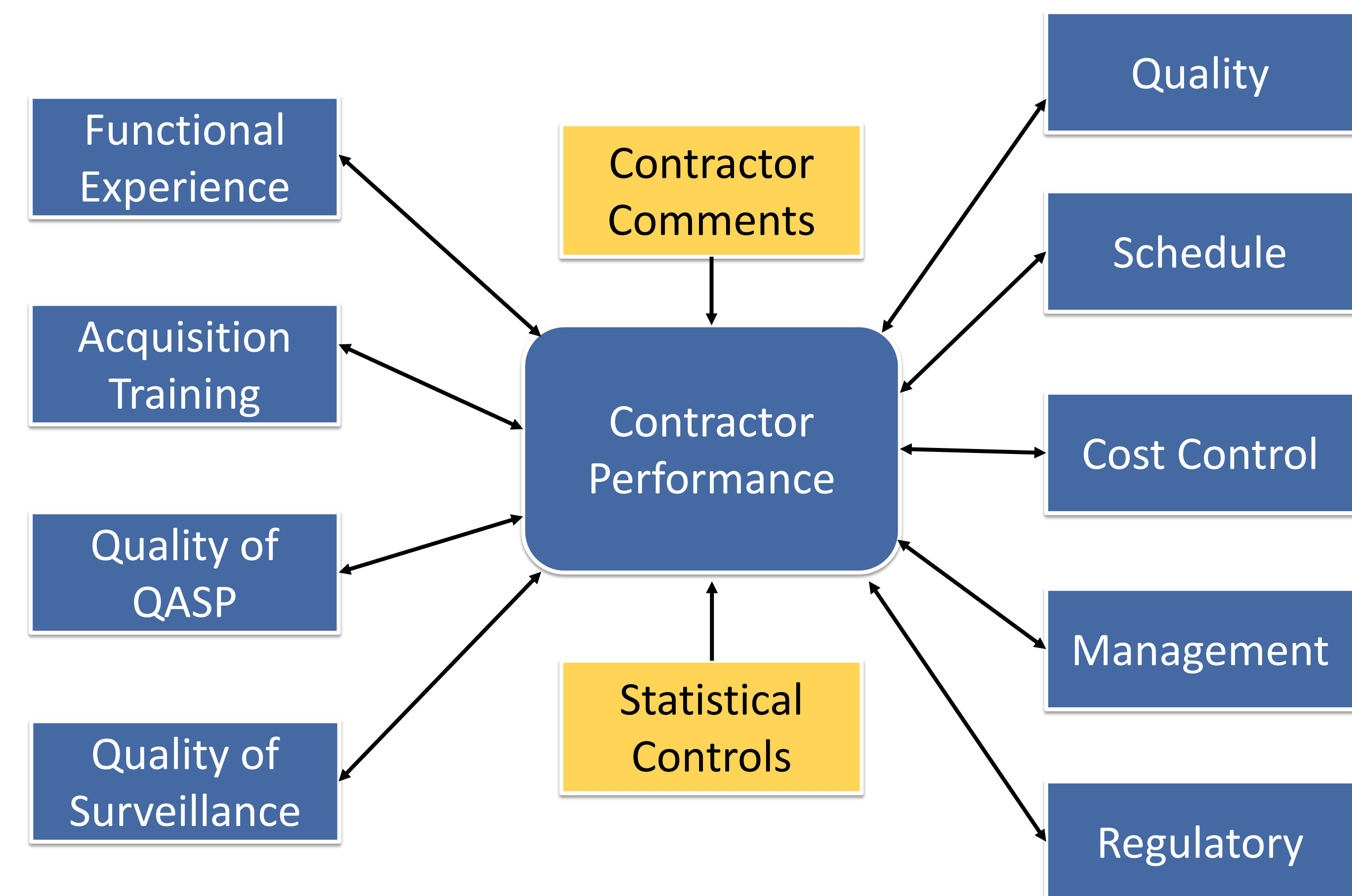

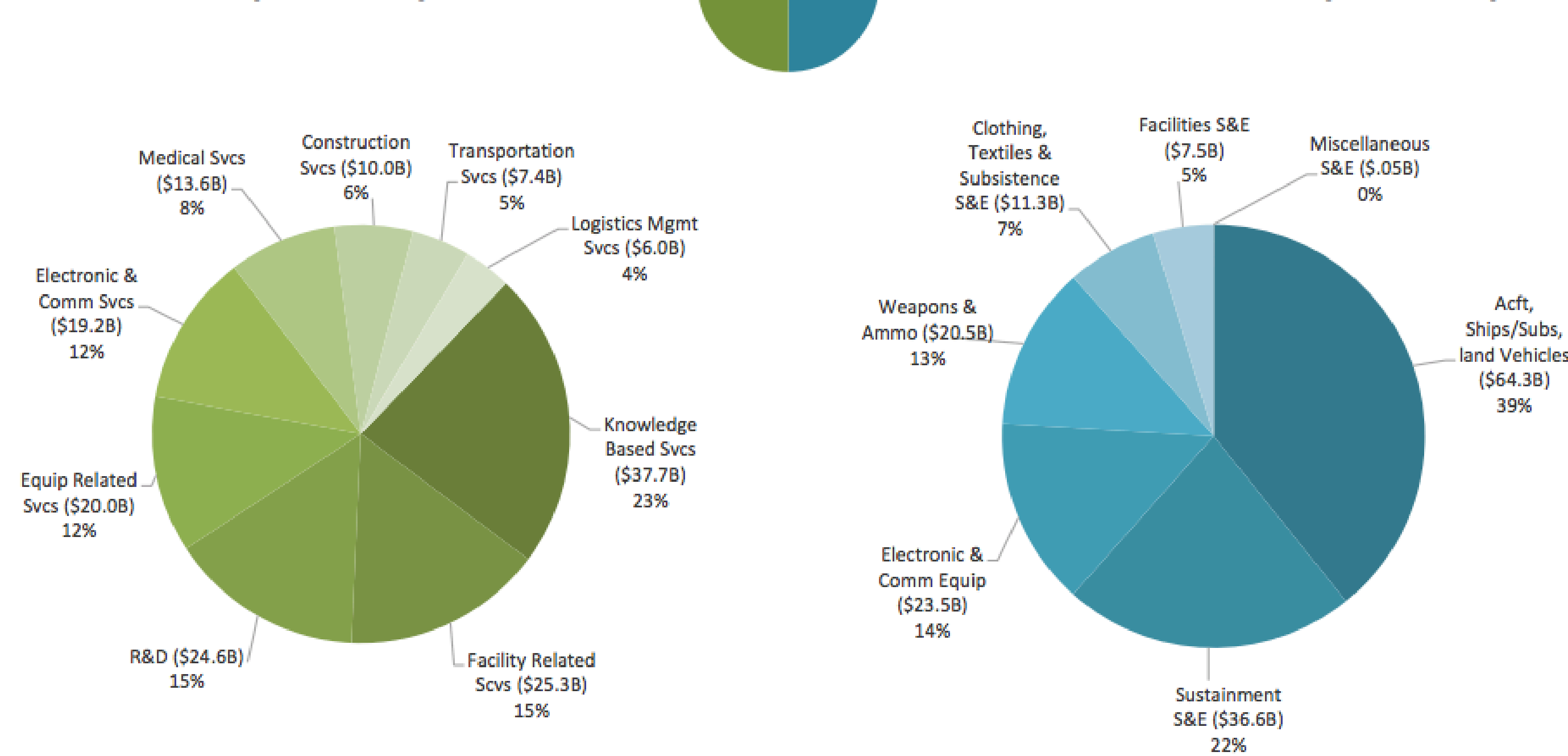
Proposed Model
