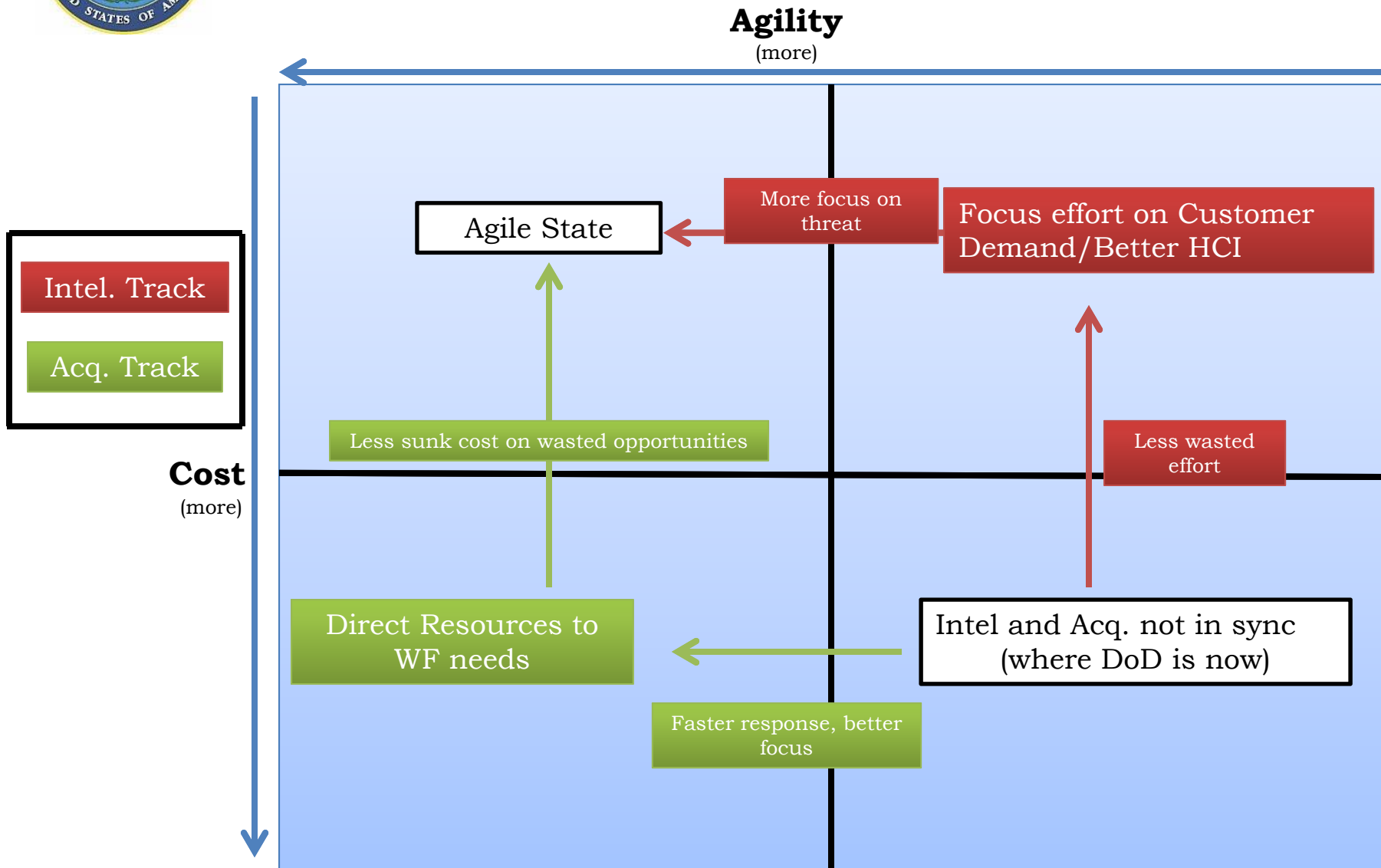
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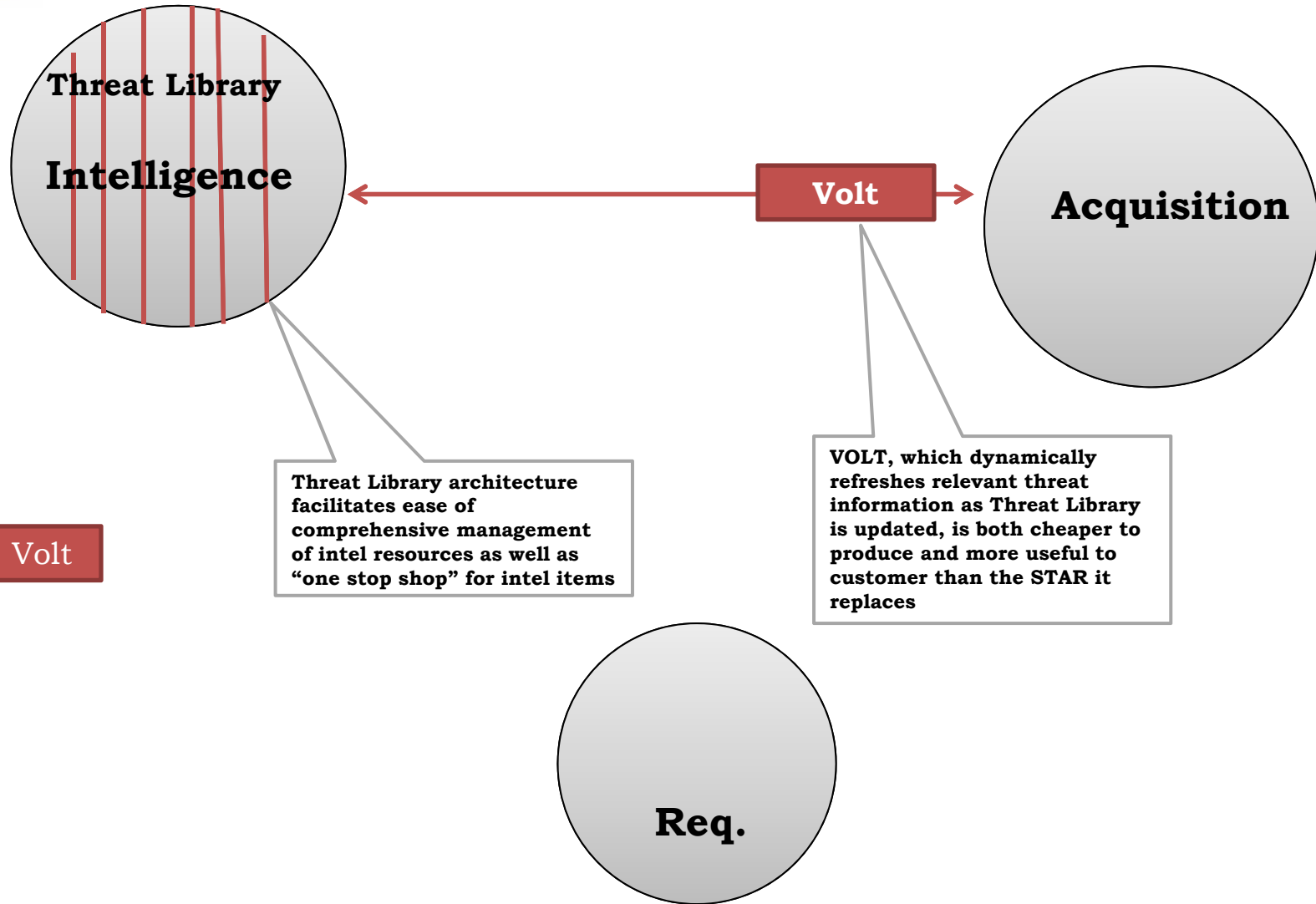


# Duplex SA Paths to Better Outcomes for Both Intel. and Acq.





# First Step: Improve Intel Delivery



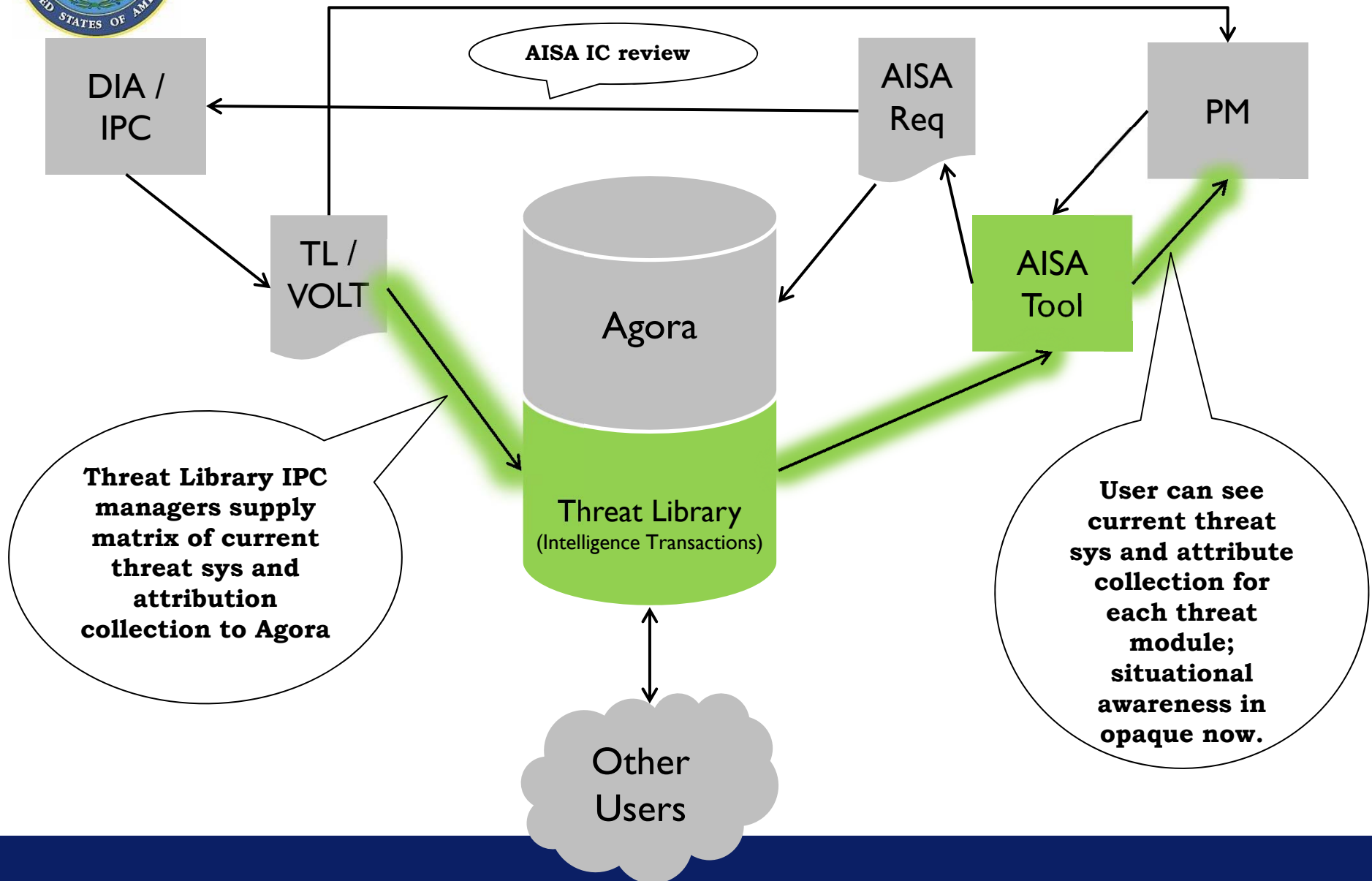


## **Stepping Beyond Current Efficiencies Requires a Customer Signal: an AISA**

- **What are the goals?**
  - **Reduce latency of acquisition OODA to evolving threat**
  - **Increase scope of acquisition's awareness of environment**
  - **Improve Intel resource efficiency**
- **Improving Intel Communities' management requires consistently collating customers' demands**
  - **Ability to meet all possible demands is limited**
  - **Triaging and prioritizing demands require comprehensive customer awareness**
- **What "customer signal" instruments are envisioned?**
  - **Acq Intel Support Agreements (AISAs)**
  - **Intel Agora**
  - **Acq / Intel / Req Task Force (AIR TF)**
- **IMD – critical though it is – a separate problem not addressed here**

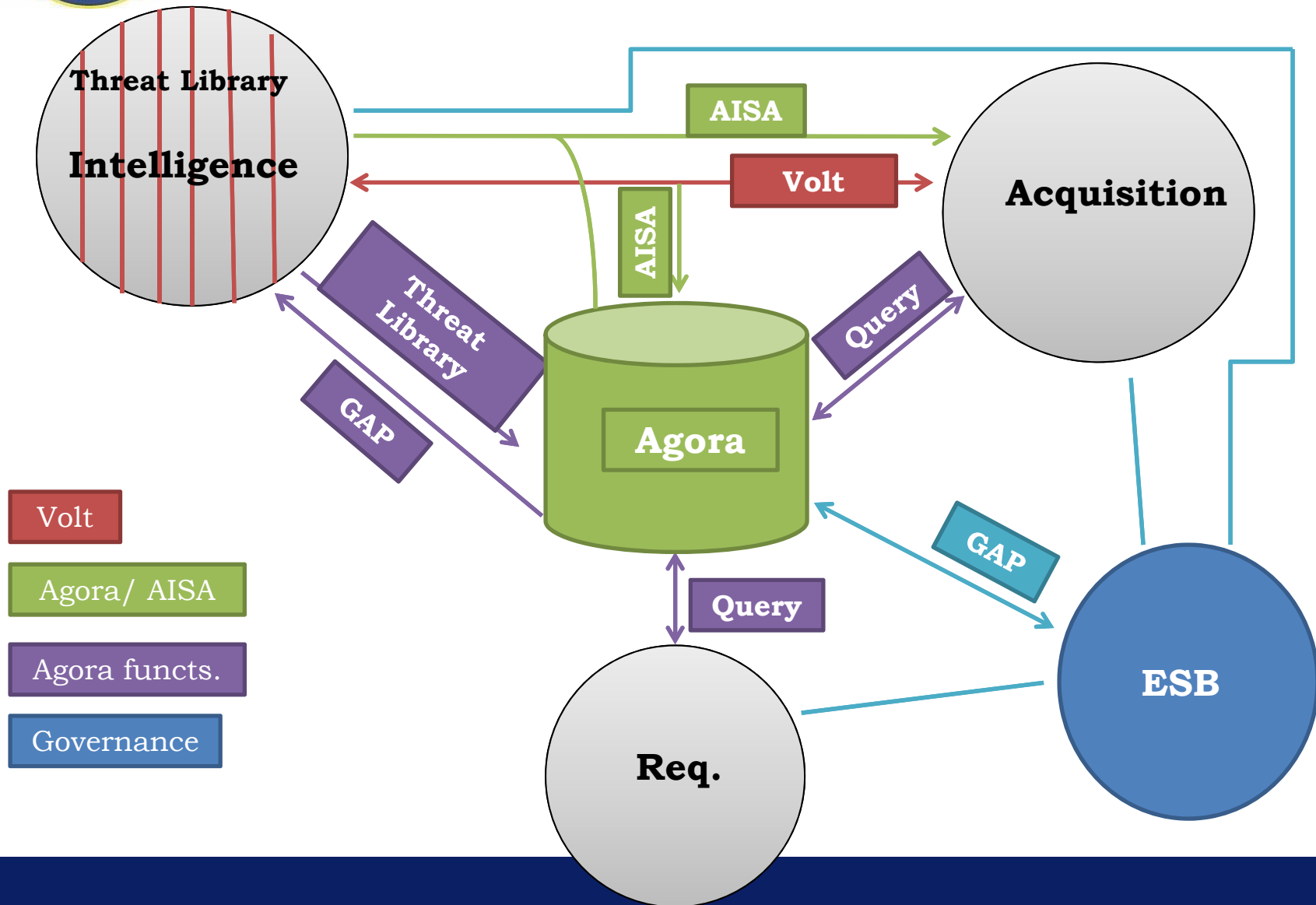

  - **AIR TF is *not* an adjudicating or decision-making office**
  - **Resources – personnel, space, and funds – already offered by USD(I), J8, and ASD(A)**
