- FY 2010 NDAA, Section 804 Implementation of New Acquisition Process for Information Technology Systems Required new process based on 2009 DSB recommendations
- Nov 2010 OSD report to Congress A New Approach for Delivering Information Technology Capabilities in the DoD
 - Informed by AFEI, IT AAC and other industry/academia inputs
- Common Principles
 - Early and continual involvement of the user
 - Multiple, rapidly executed increments or releases of capability
 - Early, successive prototyping to support an evolutionary approach
 - A modular, open systems approach
